

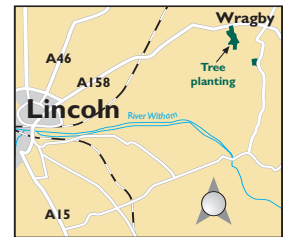
Would your community group like a free guided tour of a new woodland in Lincolnshire?
